## Support UCU members on strike to defend jobs, pay and pensions in Higher Education

We strongly oppose the **ConDem cuts** to Higher Education, the drastic **increase in tuition fees** of up to £9000 as well as the related **further marketisation of education** including attempts by the government to re-direct funding to research areas which are perceived to make a short-term economic impact.

Why we are taking industrial action:

- the failure of the employers to engage with UCU in a meaningful way about the planned changes to the USS pension scheme;
- the changes to the pension scheme will result in a two-tier system in which the final salary scheme will be closed to new members of staff;
- as a result of these changes there will be a reduction in benefits despite USS being in robust health.

We are also opposed to:

- the proposed cut in salaries and further erosion of working conditions;
- the cuts to the teaching budget which we believe could have a detrimental impact on education;
- the dramatic increase in tuition fees which is in effect transferring the cost of education to the students;
- the cuts to the EMA a vital lifeline to many students who otherwise wouldn't continue with education;

Protect your pension, job and pay: join us.
Do not go into the university on these days.
Let us fight together for the right of universal access to Further and Higher Education!

On **Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> March**, UCU members from **Nottingham University** will be on strike on these issues.
